Private Law of Capital Markets I

Course overview: The course provides an in-depth introduction to the key legal principles governing capital markets, focusing on private law aspects. Unlike traditional legal lectures, this course adopts an interdisciplinary approach, equipping students with the legal and basic economic knowledge necessary for navigating the financial sector. A special emphasis is placed on European capital markets law, including its regulatory framework, institutional structures, and recent legal developments. The course will be held in English.

Core topics: Economic and legal principles of European Capital Markets Law, Prospectus Law, Market Manipulation, Short Sales, Law of Securities
