- The academic year is divided into two semesters. The 1st semester Autumn term) starts at the beginning of September, while the 2nd semester (Spring term) starts at middle of February.
- Classes are held from mid-September to mid-December and mid-February to mid-May. Students applying to the Faculty of Law and Political Sciences are recommended to arrive one week before the semester starts for orientation. At the end of each semester, students have an exam period for oral and/or written exams. There is almost one-week break in the middle of each semester (autumn and spring break). It is possible to travel home during the pre-exam/exam period in Winter for the Christmas holidays after consulting with the teachers about exam dates at the beginning of the semester.
- Please bear in mind that the Erasmus period should also cover the exam period!
